General Information:

Tournament Start Times:

Saturday & Sunday 9:00am - Warm up arena opens at 8:00am

Eligibility: Each rider may:

- Compete in one division.
- Compete in 2 jumping heights ie. X - Rail - 18" Hunter
- Compete in one equitation class.
- Compete only once in any class.
- Compete in no more than 5 classes.

This circuit is restricted to Riders who have not competed in a class that is higher than 2'6" on any circuit other than this circuit or a similar caliber show (riders may jump 2'6" and lower at any tournament). Once a rider has jumped in a class that is higher than 2'6" at any tournament other than a Novice Rider Development tournament or similar caliber show, they are no longer eligible to compete in any Novice Rider Development tournament.

Entry Fees: \$17.00 / class (plus G.S.T.)

Entries close Tuesday prior to the competition date. Post entries may be accepted with a \$25 late fee.

Administration Fee: \$15.00 / rider

Paramedic Fee: \$15.00 / rider

Ribbons: Ribbons will be awarded to 8th place

Safety Concerns: Due to confined areas, if any particular horse acts up or is deemed to be dangerous, the horse will be excused from the tournament.

Prizes and Tournament Features:

A \$20 Equi-Products gift certificate will be awarded to a participant of each over-fences class. The winner will be drawn from all participants in that class.

Prizes will be awarded to 8th place in each flat class.
